RULES OF ENTRY FOR THIS TRIAL

Entries will be accepted on the basis of those received on each day. Confirmations will be mailed or emailed to all entered with information regarding which classes you have entered and check-in times. **Run order** will be drawn before the trial. **Bitches in season** may run in the drawn run order.

CLUB RULES FOR THE TRIAL

WSDC reserves the right to refuse an entry based on suitable causes only and in such instances, ASCA will be notified of the reasons. Every entrant must be in good standing with ASCA.

All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring. Please clean up after yourself and your dog. Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.

Any questions or problems should be brought to the attention of a WSDC member.

The trial committee is authorized to request that any dog which, in the committee's opinion, represents a hazard to persons, dogs, or property be removed from the premises. Children must be kept under the direct supervision of an adult at all times.

No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disobedience, fire and act of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Cheques not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned cheques.

No food, toys, other aids or devices will be permitted on the ring or within 10 feet of the rings at any time.

ATTENTION USA EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian Dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however; they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry fee and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks and we will not accept them as an entry. To simplify the process we urge that you purchase a bank draft or money order payable in Canadian funds.

MVA:

To earn the Most Versatile Aussie Award, each entry must earn a score from the Conformation Evaluation, a qualifying score from a regular Stockdog class and at least one qualifying score from a regular obedience, rally, or agility class. All rules per MVA rule book will be applied, except the following:

- We will allow Rally Novice Obedience to count. Will deduct 25pts from score.
- We will be awarding special MVA placement rosettes 1st – 6th and Qualifying ribbons
- A special award will be given to the MVA recipient.

If you are interested in entering the MVA competition please fill out the included MVA form and submit it with your entries. Please note there is a \$5 fee for the conformation evaluation. MVA conformation evaluations, performed by Cheryl Padgett. Each exam will be done individually and a board to sign up will be next to the ring.

AGREEMENT

THE PERSON WHO SIGNS THIS AGREEMENT REPRESENTS THAT SHE/HE IS AUTHORIZED TO ENTER INTO THIS AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF BOTH EXHIBITOR AND THE OWNER OF THE ENTERED DOG. IN CONSIDERATION OF ACCEPTANCE OF THIS ENTRY:

1. EXHIBITOR AND OWNER, WHETHER OR NOT MEMBERS OF ASCA, WILL ABIDE BY THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE AUSTRALIAN SHEPHERD CLUB OF AMERICA, INC., AND ANY OTHER RULES AND REGULATIONS APPEARING IN THE PREMIUM LIST FOR THIS EVENT.
2. EXHIBITOR AND OWNER CERTIFY THAT THE ENTERED DOG IS NOT A HAZARD TO PERSONS, DOGS OR PROPERTY.
3. EXHIBITOR AND OWNER ACKNOWLEDGE ALL HAZARDS PRESENTED BY THE EVENT AND THE EVENT PREMISES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE CONDITION OF THE FLOORS, STAIRWAYS, HALLS, LIGHTING, SECURITY MEASURES OR LACK THEREOF, ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES, SHOW RINGS, PARKING AREAS AND THE PRESENCE OF UNFAMILIAR ANIMALS AND PEOPLE; EXHIBITOR AND OWNER ASSUME THE RISK OF ANY HARM ARISING FROM THESE.

**INDEMNIFICATION AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY
AGREEMENT**

In consideration of my/our participation in this/these event(s), I/we agree to assume all responsibility for any claim, loss or damage, of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property, which may be caused at or near this event. I/we further agree that I/we will hold Tee Creek Dog Training, its officers and agents, and the owners of the facility and stock, and all volunteers, the host Club and sanctioning body and all officers, directors and members thereof, harmless and defend them from any and all liability for any injury, death, damage or loss, of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property, caused at or near this/these event(s) whether directly or indirectly, by or to me or any dog I have entered in and/or brought to this/these event(s). I agree to indemnify Tee Creek Dog Training Inc., its officers and agents, the owners of the facility and the stock, and any volunteers and all others mentioned above from any loss, cost or expense including, but not limited to, attorneys' fees and costs to which any of the aforesaid parties may be subject to as a result of any claim, suit, loss of damage caused in any way by any act or negligence on my part or on the part of any dog or dogs which I have entered in and/or brought to this/these event(s).

I/we agree that any of the parties holding and hosting this/these event(s) have the right to refuse this entry at their sole discretion.

I/we certify and represent that the dog(s) which I have entered in and/or brought to this event are healthy and do not pose a hazard to other dogs, livestock or people.

I/we agree to pay the full market value (\$1000. for cattle, \$350. for St. Croix sheep and goats, \$200. for other sheep, \$35. for ducks and geese, \$50. for turkeys) of any livestock whose death results from the actions of me and/or my dog(s), whether willful or accidental. In the case of injury to any livestock resulting from the actions of me and/or my dog(s) I/we agree to pay all veterinary fees up to the market value of the animal.

I/we agree to pay the cost of supplies and labour to repair any damage to fences/gates/equipment which occurs as a result of the actions, either direct or indirect, of me and/or my dog(s), whether willful or accidental.

I/we understand that there are risks and dangers inherent in training stock dogs to herd, handle and move livestock. I/we also understand that in order to be allowed to participate and use any animal in this/these events, I/we understand and agree to be responsible for injury or damage caused by me or my dog(s). I/we also understand and accept any and all risks associated with this/these events including, but not limited to, falls, contacts with livestock, the effects of weather and any other potentially hazardous conditions associated with the event site.

I/we understand and agree that the safety of livestock is of primary importance, and harassment of livestock will not be tolerated. Any run may be terminated if required to preserve the safety of livestock, and I/we hereby agree to waive any claim for damages or other compensation including, but not limited to a refund of entry fees.

I/we understand and agree that this indemnification and waiver is binding on all owners and handlers of dogs entered, is enduring in nature and may not be withdrawn or cancelled while I/we continue to participate in events at the premises of Tee Creek Dog Training Inc.
