Two Trials Each Day - Limited to no more than 50 runs per trial, all classes of stock combined Nor more than 14 cattle runs, 12 Geese runs per trial. Sheep to make up the rest.

ENTRIES - PRE-ENTRIES open (postmark): ASCA registered Australian Shepherds – August 14. All Other Breeds August 17.

Pre-Entries Close(postmark): September 12. Entries postmarked after closing date will be taken at Day of rate. Day of trial entries will be taken if the trial is not full.

All entries must have a postmark. NO hand delivered entries accepted. Entries must be made on the official ASCA entry form.

REFUNDS: If a trial fills, a waiting list will be maintained. No refunds will be made unless that entry can be filled from the waiting list. Entry fees will be refunded only when a dog has been certified by a licensed Veterinarian as unable to compete due to sickness or injury. Owner will be responsible for all vet fees. Dogs may be substituted if owned by the same person.

COVID-19 INFORMATION

If either of the following conditions apply to you, please DO NOT attend this trial. Contact the Trial Secretary if you wish to request a refund for any runs not yet completed.

- You were exposed to COVID-19 within the 14 days preceding the trial and do not have confirmed negative result from testing done after the exposure.
- If you have COVID-19 or any of its symptoms at the time of the trial, or feel ill in any way during the trial.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The trial will be run and judged under ASCA rules as published in the most current rulebook. Run order will be drawn in advance. Bitches in season will run in order. All non-ASCA registered dogs must have an ASCA tracking number to receive ASCA titles. See https://www.asca.org/or call (979) 778-1082

Run Order will be drawn before trial. Bitches in Season will run in order.

Dogs must be confined or on leash at all times when not working or in a designated exercise area. Individuals are responsible for any damage done to stock and/or facilities. Dogs that attack or maul any person, dog or livestock will be disqualified.

STOCK REPLACEMENT FEES: \$100 per goose, \$300 per sheep and Market Value on cattle. Owner of dog will be responsible for any veterinary expense to the stock.

<u>FOOD</u>: Plan to bring your own water and food. Some food options in Lakeville. There is a chance to order out for a delivery, too.

High Combined WTCH Australian Shepherd – Rosette - highest combined qualifying scores from all 6 trials **High Combined Non-WTCH Australian Shepherd** – Rosette - highest combined qualifying scores from all 6 trials. For Australian Shepherds that begin the trials not having earned the WTCH title. Scores may be earned in the Open and/or Advanced divisions.

Most Promising Started Australian Shepherd – Rosette - highest combined qualifying scores from started from 6 trials.

High Combined Other Breed – highest combined qualifying scores from all 6 trials.

High Combined Owner, Breeder, Handler – highest combined qualifying scores from all 6 trials – Owner must have bred the dog and handle the dog for all classes. Please let us know before the trial starts if you are eligible.

Entry and Tracking Forms: Entries must be on an official ASCA entry form. Entry forms can be downloaded from www.asca.org If your dog is not ASCA® registered you must have a tracking number in order for your titles to be counted, but a tracking number is not required to compete.

It is your responsibility to know the rules and regulations of ASCA. Rulebooks and entry forms are available online at www.asca.org


<u>DIRECTIONS</u> 6952 Harder Road Hemlock, NY – Watch for signs Call Anya's (585) 478-7060 or Jean's cell phone – 716-270-9718 There will be herding signs out front. ** Blank Road is closed and no access to Anya's Farm from there. ** Follow the directions below to avoid the Road Closure**

NYS Thruway Exit 46 (for I-390 South) from the north, east or west - Keep right for I-390 South (Corning) 11 miles Exit 10 for Avon/Lima. Turn left onto NY-5/US 20 east. 3 miles turn right onto Livonia Center Road. In 5 miles turn left onto Federal Road. In 4 miles turn left onto Harder Road. Flying Bucket Farm ½ mile on left.


Coming from the South – **I-86 to I-390 North**. About 16 miles take exit for NY 15 / Rte 21. ½ mile turn Right onto NY 15N. About 15 miles turn Right onto Federal Rd. 3.5 miles turn Right onto Harder Road. Flying Bucket Farm ½ mile on left.


Housekeeping:
