**Entries will not be accepted without fees.** Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Herding Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with an international money order guaranteed in U.S. funds.

**Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies without the agreement and rules are unacceptable.** Telephone, telegraph, fax, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after the closing date.

**The club may decline entries** for cause and may refuse to receive or remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

## Trial Regulations

**Proof of current rabies vaccination** must be furnished upon request.

**All dogs must be held on leash**, except during tests or trials. This is a working farm. There is no off leash exercise area and dogs are expected to be under control at all times while on the trial grounds. Dogs must be kept a suitable distance away from the test/trial area. Handlers should bring water and provide shade for their dogs. Handlers are required to pick up after their dogs.

**Bitches in season** shall be eligible and will run at the end of the class in Tests and in catalog order as listed in the class in Trials. Bitches in season are asked to please remain in their crating area when not in the arena. Please notify the Herding Secretary before the beginning of a test class if a bitch is in season.

**In the case of livestock injury** caused by an entered dog, the owner will assume total responsibility for any damage and agrees to pay the veterinarian bill for minor injuries, or the full market value of the injured animal (Sheep – \$300. Ducks – \$50) in case of serious injury.

**Costs to repair property damage** caused by an entered dog will be paid for by the dog's owner.
