ENTRY FEE: \$65 for A & C Courses, \$55 for HT & PT, \$30.00 for FDC.

No entries will be accepted by fax, phone, hand delivery, or unsigned. Entries must be made on the official AKC form, signed by the owner or authorized handler. A separate entry form must be completed for each dog entered, per the AKC rules and regulations. Returned checks will not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection of \$30.00 to the amount for each returned check.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course. with the same kind of stock under the same judge at any trial. The Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.

All dogs nine (9) months of age or older from breeds accepted into the herding program

that are registered with The American Kennel Club are eligible to participate in herding tests and trials. However, dogs may enter an Instinct test at six months of age. Bitches in season shall be eligible and will run at the end of the level in tests and in catalog order as listed in the level in trials.

Dogs that are lame, blind or deaf shall not be permitted to participate. Lameness means any derangement of normal movement, disabled or with impaired freedom of movement. Blind means without useful vision, and deaf means without useful hearing. Dogs wearing bandages or with stitches or open sores shall not be permitted to participate in herding tests or trials.

Then turn right at the stop light onto 15A south. Follow 15A south to Harder Rd and then turn left. Coming from the South - I-86 to I-390 North Follow I-390 North to Avon Exit – Exit 10. Turn right onto 20 E and then turn left onto Heath Markham Rd. Cross over 15A onto Harder Rd.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
