Entries will not be accepted without fees. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Herding Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with an international money order guaranteed in U.S. funds.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies without the agreement and rules are unacceptable. Telephone, telegraph, fax, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after the closing date.

The club may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

Trial Regulations

All dogs must be held on leash, except during tests or trials. Dogs must be kept a suitable distance away from the test/trial area. Handlers should bring water and provide shade for their dogs. Handlers are required to pick up after their dogs.

Proof of current rabies vaccination must be furnished upon request.

Competitor will cover any bills incurred for damage to the stock or facility. Bill to be determined by stock/property owner.

For-Exhibition-Only Entries will be accepted in all classes, each day, at the same entry fee as the corresponding regular classes. FEO entries will be taken up to 30 minutes before the start of the event. They will be judged at the end of the regular classes, and will only be accommodated after regular entries for alternates and move ups have been accommodated.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
